Each day campers, grouped by age, participate in two to four classes including sculpture, drawing, painting, ceramic art and theater. During each 2-week session we'll explore a new theme in surprising ways. Come spend your summer making art with us!



PAINTING, DRAWING & PRINTMAKING

Students gain skills in various painting media, drawing techniques, and printing processes including embossing, stamping, monoprints and collagraphs.

CERAMICS, SCULPTURE, COLLAGE & ASSEMBLAGE

Students use found objects, traditional art materials, paper maché and paint to create

3-D pieces. Students explore clay through pinch, coil and slab building to make anything from functional pottery to hand built sculpture.



THEATRE

Get up and play! Professional theater artists guide campers through acting techniques via games, improvisation and storytelling. All campers have a chance to perform in our theater on the final day of each session!





SWIM TRIPS

Conklin Pool is a five-minute bus ride away, and provides supervised free swim for our full-day campers, on Wednesday afternoons. Each child is given a swim test to determine their ability level.

The pool is life guarded and counselors are in each part of the pool to supervise. Sessions 1-4 only. Session 1, no pool trip 7/2.



All classes are led by professional art teachers chosen for their experience and



love of working with kids. Our enthusiastic, college age counselors will stay with your child's age group throughout their camp session. Full-day campers bring their own lunch and water bottle, and picnic together with their counselors at noon.

- A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required per child per session to secure all registrations and will be credited towards the total amount due.
- Full payment must be received by June 6 for Crafty Kids 1 and Sessions 1&2; by July 11 for Sessions 3&4 and Crafty Kids 2. No camper may attend if full fees are not paid.
- Members receive a tuition discount.
- Sibling discount: Each additional student receives a \$25 discount per camp session (\$10 for Crafty Kids).
- Register by May 1st and receive 5% off total tuition. Full payment required by 11:59pm 5/1/25.

- Covid Policy: Upon registration families agree to abide by all current Center Covid policies and restrictions. Please see our website for up-to-date information.
