## Juror's Statement

2021 began with many of us still confined to home or the immediate environs of our community; institutions like the Cheltenham Center for the Arts acted as a safe-haven and respite from the grim realities that were still unfolding. Art became an affirming gesture of continuing vitality. With that as lingering memory and present again reality, it was a pleasure to see so many creative voices display their talents in the member exhibition –from the virtuosic craft of “old” masters to the vibrant enthusiasm of those whose path has just begun. The work represented the diversity of our community, through the variety of media and subject matter; it was very hard for me to select prize winners. In the end I was drawn to work that engaged with the world and revealed in some way a persistent sense of the wonder it continues to provide. There were examinations of things close at hand in the home or experienced on daily walks as we sought to escape the endless repetition of a world still trying to return to “normal”. The streets of our neighborhood, the profile of an especially beautiful tree or flowers arranged carefully in a vase by the window, everything perhaps took on new significance. The work recognized new civic leaders and those who just stopped to admire the view, but mostly it celebrated the time, skill and artistry of being in the studio making work. ## Juror's Biography

David Hartt lives in Elkins Park with his wife Catherine and their two sons. He is a visual artist and an Assistant Professor, in the Department of Fine Arts at the University of Pennsylvania. His work explores how historic ideas and ideals persist or transform over time.

Recent solo and group exhibitions include *The Histories* at the Hammer Museum, Los Angeles, *Reconstructions: Architecture and Blackness in America* at The Museum of Modern Art, New York and *New Grit: Art & Philly Now*, The Philadelphia Museum of Art, Philadelphia.

His work is in the public collections of The Museum of Modern Art, New York, Whitney Museum of American Art, New York, The Studio Museum in Harlem, New York, The RISD Museum, Providence, The Art Institute of Chicago, Museum of Contemporary Art, Chicago, The Museum of Contemporary Photography, Chicago, Henry Art Gallery, Seattle, The J. Paul Getty Museum, Los Angeles, The National Gallery of Canada, Ottawa and The Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam.
